# **Path Upgrades**

Following the requests of several members, both individually and at the last AGM, and after an extremely wet winter, FoBH have improved the path running from Edmund Beaufort Drive to the corner of Waverley Road, plus short stretches on either side of Harpenden Road. Several people have commented on being able now to walk along these paths which had become almost impassable. On this occasion, the whole cost was borne by the Friends' funds.
